A popular choice among many Pre-school Art Coordinators is to have children create artwork using HAND PRINTS.





Hand print artwork is fun and easy! The artwork can be very basic with only a few simple steps or more involved depending on the artist's ability.

Please refer to the following pages for a sampling of HAND PRINT based artwork. Remember that the artwork is only limited by your imagination.





1) Start with a solid blue background.
We used blue paint on heavy white paper.
Let this fully dry before proceeding to the next step.




Create a flower garden

HANDS ON can be simple and easy!








Or more involved



- 1) Start by choosing your background, fill the paper with color using the media of your choice, in this instance solid colored construction paper was utilized.
- 2) Decide on a border. We used cut pieces of two differently colored construction paper.
- 3) Have the artist cover their hand firmly on the middle of the background page. Let dry completely.
- 4) Finally, sign the artwork (stay at least $\frac{1}{2}$ " away from the paper edge) to complete a timeless masterpiece.
